NATURE NOTE

Help Struggling Monarchs

Sadly, monarch migration numbers are becoming smaller each year, as it has become harder for monarchs to find the right conditions to survive and make their incredible journey. Add these to your yard to help them out: **Milkweed** is absolutely vital to the survival of monarchs. Seek out those native to our area and plant as much as you can. **Nectar Flowers:** Plants like asters, cosmos, zinnias and goldenrod provide the energy migrating butterflies need. **Shelter.** These intrepid fliers need safe havens for rest. Shrubs and ornamental grasses are ideal. Avoid so-called "butterfly houses," which butterflies rarely use but which often attract wasps and other predators. - *Birds and Blooms*
