WEEKLY BLUEBIRD REPORT

In our final bluebird report of the season, the last bluebird chicks fledged this past week making a yearly total of 642 fledged chicks. We fledged 655 chicks in 2017 and 576 chicks in 2016. Thank you to all the monitors who faithfully checked their boxes and reported each week. It's time to clean out the nest boxes so the birds can use them for winter housing. The birds usually start nesting in late March or early April, so we'll start our reports again at that time.
