THE INNSBROOK FISHING CLUB - FISHING REPORT

The water temperatures are nearly 80 degrees. Water clarity is currently stained in most lakes. Bass are in transition, moving from deepwater schools to staging areas near the shallows. Fish steep underwater slopes targeting 6-8' depth. Bass are slow, but biting on soft plastics and long retrieve, lipless crank baits. Record bass so far this year is 6 lbs., 6oz. Good luck and catch a lunker!
