### MYTHS AND MISCONCEPTIONS ABOUT MISSOURI SNAKES: A FUN QUIZ!

Living in harmony with nature and wildlife is at the heart of what makes Innsbrook special. Snakes are sometimes seen around the resort, though they're afraid of people and would rather keep to themselves.
