MILES TO FLY BEFORE WINTER

In the fall, monarch butterflies travel 3,000 miles to a forest in Mexico, only to return to the Midwest in the spring. It takes four generations to complete the journey. These mighty butterflies are the only butterfly to migrate the long distance. The butterflies can reach a speed of nearly 20 miles per hour, gliding on favorable winds to speed them along the journey.



Monarchs aren't just another pretty wing. These butterflies feed on the nectar of the milkweed plant and pollinate many types of wildflowers, contributing to the health of our community.

These creatures are in decline due to inclement weather and habitat loss. Planting milkweed and nectar plants close together creates shelters for monarchs and other wildlife.
