FORGOTTEN FRUIT OR SUPERFOOD?

Recently Elise Orf, part of Innsbrook's highly-skilled horticulture team, shared pawpaws that she found growing in the wild at Innsbrook. "Pawpaws are a tropical fruit native to Missouri," said Orf. "It's sweet, tasting like banana and papaya. You can eat it raw or baked." The pawpaw is the fruit from a large shrub with a slender trunk that grows with sweet gum, sycamore and dogwood trees. The trees flower in March through May and self-pollinate. The fruit ripens in September through October. Raccoons, squirrels and opossums often consume these treats, making them challenging to find.



Pawpaw extract is being studied as a possible cancer-fighting drug. The extract is high in antioxidants.
