## nature note

### BIRDS SINGING IN THE NIGHT

The purple martin is the largest member of the swallow family, often being measured at eight inches from the tip of its bill to the tail. These glossy, purplish blue-tinted beauties appear black in low light and they can be heard singing, often just a few hours before dawn.

These birds enjoy catching insects and helping control the insect population. In August, they gather in a flock to begin migrating southward. If you want to help these birds, leave crushed eggshells in your backyard to help aid in their digestion. The oldest known purple martin lived to be 13 years and nine months old.
