nature notes

The eastern chipmunk is a small, ground-dwelling squirrel with lengthwise stripes on the back, sides and cheeks. The color of the upper-body is reddish brown. There are five dark brown to blackish lengthwise stripes from shoulders to end, with a white band between the two stripes on each side.



Chipmunks prefer timber borderland rather than deep forests and are solitary, even territorial. Occasionally they live around city homes and farmhouses, where they live in shrubbery, stone walls and old buildings.

Chipmunks stuff nuts and seeds into their cheek pouches and transport them to their burrows for storage. These animals store nuts, seeds, berries, hickory nuts, acorns, beechnuts, hazelnuts, walnuts, plus corn and wheat. The storage chamber in a chipmunk burrow may contain up to half a bushel of nuts and seeds. Chipmunks relish but do not store perishable foods such as mushrooms and many types of berries. Occasionally chipmunks eat insects and their larvae, millipedes, earthworms, slugs, snails and other small animals.

Different chipmunks hibernate more or less than others, with some becoming completely dormant in winter, some active during mild periods and others active all winter. Hibernation ends by early March and then breeding begins in spring. Most young are born in April and May, or in July and August. Females have one or two litters a year with one to eight young. The young start exploring above-ground when five or six weeks old. An eastern chipmunk can live up to five years in the wild.
