nature notes

FLYING SQUIRRELS

Well-known lyrics from a Tom Petty song describes the flying squirrel in a nutshell. "I'm learning to fly; but I ain't got wings."



The southern flying squirrel is a chipmunk-sized rodent with large dark eyes, a slightly upturned nose and large ears, all of which make it look a little like a mouse. Between its front and back legs is a loose flap of skin that the squirrel stretches like a kite when it is ready to "fly." Its soft, silky fur is mostly gray on top and white on the bottom. The males and females look alike.

Flying squirrels live in holes made in trees, usually from woodpeckers. They can squeeze into a hole about the size of a quarter, so they could even live in a wren house or attic. They prefer mature forests with plenty of old or rotten trees.

Like most squirrels, they eat nuts, fruits, berries, buds, tree bark and mushrooms. Unlike most squirrels, they also eat moths, beetles and wood-burrowing insects. Many animals also eat them, including bobcats, raccoons, weasels, owls, hawks and tree-climbing snakes. These squirrels feed on the buds of trees, stimulating tree growth.

Between four and six babies are born in the spring; sometimes a second litter is born in late summer. When they're first born, the babies are naked and blind and weigh about as much as six paper clips. They grow fast and live to nearly five or six years old. These nocturnal mammals cover the same trees and areas at night that their larger relatives, the gray and fox squirrels, occupy by day.
