This week, we have 88 nests, containing 113 eggs, 197 chicks and 89 chicks have fledged. If the chicks have fledged from your nest box, be sure to pull the old nests and throw them away. MIGRATORY BIRDS RETURNING TO IBK

Many of our migratory summer birds are presently returning to Innsbrook. Some have flown thousands of miles to come here to raise their families. A large flock of ruby-throated hummingbirds arrived over the past week, so it's time to put your feeders out. They drink nectar and sugar water (four parts water to one part sugar and no food coloring) and eat small insects and spiders. The Baltimore orioles have also arrived and are really fond of Welch's grape jelly (not Walmart brand, however). We've also seen rosy-breasted grosbeaks, blue grosbeaks, indigo buntings, king birds and rufous-sided towhees. Warblers, vireos and tanagers should be here soon. So take out your binoculars and a good bird book, sit back and enjoy the beauty of the birds.
