IRRIGATION UPGRADE COMPLETE

After five months of hard work, installation of the new, state-of-the-art Toro irrigation system is complete! Despite the harsh winter weather, the project finished as scheduled, just in time for some of the best golf weather of the year.

87,000 linear feet of pipe and 133.5 miles of wiring (a few miles further than the distance from IBK to the Lake of the Ozarks) make up this new system, which will have the course grass looking and playing better than ever with the help of a few weeks of spring sun!

As soon as weather permits, ten remaining cart paths will be overlaid, others will be repaired and bare areas in fairways will be sodded. Ext. 9203.
