

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HISTORY OF OUR COMMUNITY

The history of Innsbrook is a tale of dedication, love of nature and family, and growth and change across more than five decades.



The Early Years

Innsbrook began as a dream for late founder Ed Boyce. A dream to bring the charm and serenity of Colorado's A-frame cabins right here to the Midwest – a weekend getaway

from the never-ending hectic pace of city living, less than an hour from St. Louis.

Joining Boyce in making the Innsbrook dream come true in the '70s were Warren Wobbe, Sr. and Les Buechele, who through their own blood, sweat and tears, alongside their families and



associates, built hundreds of A-frames, constructed lakes, built tennis courts and completed roads.

About Innsbrook

The name "Innsbrook" is a nod to the capital of Austria's Tyrol region, another place where beautiful A-frames can be found clustered around small lakes.

Building from Innsbrook's humble A-frame origins, they developed permanent residences, condos and villas when there was demand for year-round and vacation homes. Then came the cottages as an in-between option.

Transition Over the Years

A true family endeavor, the late '80s saw the addition of Boyce's son, Charlie, and Wobbe's son, Warren "Chip" Wobbe, Jr., to the Innsbrook Corporation. Years of hard work and

In 1998, after much planning, discussion and petitiongathering, Innsbrook made it official and incorporated as a village, as approved by Warren County.

Innsbrook Expansions & Amenity Additions

With more than 100 lakes, two still manage to stand out. 150-acre Lake Aspen is the focal point of the east side of the

development, which is also home to a public 18-hole golf course, Clubhouse Bar & Grille and the banquet/ event center.



As Innsbrook continued to

expand to the west side of Highway F, along came Alpine Lake in 2000 – a 236-acre beauty and Innsbrook's largest body of water.

The Charrette Creek Commons – a family activity-oriented amenity complex opened in 2016. A hub for community



togetherness, Charrette Creek Commons is home to a swimming pool and lazy river, fitness center, the Summerhaus poolside eatery,

outdoor amphitheater, children's playground and more.

In 2018, the excitement continued with a new region of recreational and residential properties. The newest area of development is named "Tyrol" in honor of Innsbrook's home region, which connects western Austria to northern Italy. A Tyrolean entrance off of Stracks Church Rd. allows access to the area.

In 2020, the Aspen Center has added the beautiful Sycamore Terrace, an expansive room with 180 degree views of Lake Aspen, perfect for weddings and other special events.

This year saw the addition of the Treehouses of Talblick, a brand new type of home in the Tyrolean area of Innsbrook. This all-new concept blurs the lines between stylish contemporary home design and your childhood dream


hideaway high above the forest floor. Phase I opened with 12 lots and an additional 22 lots were offered in Phase II. Each that feature dramatic elevation changes with stunning bird'seye views. Phase III lots are available now.

Also in 2022, Innsbrook opened the brand new Market Cafe and Creamery, a coffee shop serving your favorite brews and snacks next to the Country Market. The old fire station was renovated to expand the offerings at the Market, which now includes the cafe/coffee shop, convenience store, and boutique. This replaces the Aspen Cafe which was at the Aspen Center. The Market Cafe and Creamery features Starbucks brand drinks, hot and cold foods, ice cream and other sundries.

2023 marked the opening of the Tyrolean Oasis, a new community pool in the Tyrol area. This play pool is shallow enough for kids, but quiet enough for adults who just want to relax. The cabana building boasts two restrooms, and there are picnic tables for guests to sit at and eat if they choose.

With more than 7,500 acres (that's over five-and-a-half times the size of Forest Park!) and more than 100 lakes (with even more to come!), Innsbrook is a wonderful, one-of-a-kind recreation-centered community that we look forward to sharing for years to come.

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




Tyrolean Region continues with Treehouse expansion and future development plans on the horizon.

Now that the new golf carts are here, we want to make certain everybody is enjoying the full benefits they provide. Moving forward, private golf carts will not be allowed on the golf course, with the exception of those players who purchase annual passes.
