

NEW CARTS MAKE FOR MORE EVEN GAME Play, better greens

2023 is shaping up to be another banner year for Innsbrook golf! Always improving, the course has undergone some updates and upgrades in the last year, recently welcomed the delivery of new GPS-enabled golf carts, and of course, the return of our favorite food truck, the Par Bar.

Upgrades Along the Course

New technology has hit the course this year in the form of four-wheels. Players are now able to ride through their nine or 18-holes of play in a new fleet of Club Car golf carts featuring a GPS system. The new carts bring wonderful improvements to the playing experience at Innsbrook. Now, there will be no more searching for yardage markers or making sure your laser range finder catches the flag to determine your distance – that information and more will be right in front of you as you pull up to your golf ball. These new carts will also help our staff better manage the golf course and improve maintenance practices. These systems will allow golf course management to track all golf



carts, monitor the pace of play, restrict parts of the course where carts are prohibited, and send messages to specific golf carts and players from inside the pro shop.

This high level of technology will deliver helpful and realtime location information for players to manage their pace of play and plan their next shot, as well as a cost-effective and efficient communication system for golf course management to instantly communicate with players.

Now that the new golf carts are here, we want to make certain everybody is enjoying the full benefits they provide. Moving forward, private golf carts will not be allowed on the golf course, with the exception of those players who purchase annual passes.

Par Bar and Patio

In 2021, the Par Bar rolled its way into its VIP parking space at the turn and end of the 18th hole, providing a literal meal on wheels for property owners, players, and guests alike. The Par Bar's attractive new form and convenient location offers an additional eatery in the Innsbrook community for those to swing by for a quick bite on the way to the next tee box, or a place to dine alfresco with family on the new pro shop patio. This year, the Par Bar is back and better than ever with delicious new menu items, a line-up of summer events, and an eager staff of Innsbrook all-stars ready to please palates with their easyto-eat and on-the-go favorites.

The unique "19th hole" food truck features delicious golf-themed items and ice-cold beverages. Patrons can experience a "Caddy Shack" meal with "The Bill Murray" bratwurst, or get a little taste of Augusta with the "Master" turkey and provolone sandwich. Par Bar originals including the Par Bar premium burger, "The 18th Hole" smoky brisket burnt ends sandwich, and Innsbrook's popular funnel fries are just a few of the other menu options bursting with flavor. Along with the new additions to the menu, patrons can now enjoy lunch and cocktails on the expanded patio right outside of the pro shop doors. Recently outfitted with a custom pergola, cozy course-side seating and outdoor games, the patio serves as the perfect place to relax on a sunny Saturday afternoon surrounded by the scenic views of the championship golf course. With a focus on providing the Innsbrook community and guests a unique outdoor dining experience and an additional space to gather with family friends, patrons can expect a summer calendar sprinkled with golf specials, live music, events and parties at the Par Bar.

Off-Season Course Maintenance

Players who wish to take a few practice swings at the driving range before they hit the links will now experience a drier, more functional range environment. During the off-season, the course installed multiple drains throughout the range that connect to a 12" drain pipe that spans the entire length of the driving range. Prior to the installation, the driving range was not equipped with a drainage system, causing the range to hold excess amounts of precipitation, as well as lose range balls in the quagmire.

The new system will prevent the range from holding excessive amounts of water and in turn, allow the course to keep the driving range open more often than in previous seasons. Course management also completed significant clearing along the sides of the driving range. The offseason project will allow staff to easily retrieve errant golf balls deep into the tree line.

Smooth greens and fine-tuned roughs are an essential part of every player's golf experience. In order to provide a high-quality playing field for all, the golf course has recently received a new John Deere greens and rough mower, both of which are used on a daily basis and are crucial components of course maintenance and upkeep. Our new equipment is set to cut greens from 0.125 inches, to 0.130 inches, while the rough mower is set to 2.5 inches, similar to residential lawn mowers.

These improvements and additions offer benefits far beyond a round of golf. Property owners and guests can look forward to an ever-improving and beautiful environment on and around the course, as well as new amenities to enhance the Innsbrook golf experience.

SADDLE UP FOR EQUINE FUN DUN RIGHT At Innsbrook's stables

There's a relaxing sensation when a horse lover steps onto the field, tacks up and mounts their horse, especially on a beautiful, sunny day at Innsbrook. When the clippity-clop of the horse's shoes begin drumming the ground, riders are at ease taking in the sights of the stables updates, clean trails and amazing views.

As you pass by the herd of painted horses along the white picket fence line, you feel yourself pause in that moment, taking in the simplicities of life. Then without even knowing you start to breathe deeper with nature, and just let go. Winston Churchill once said, "There is something about the outside of the horse that's good for the inside of a soul."

Dun Right Stables, a privately managed and leased Innsbrook Stables facility, provides year round services including semester based Horsemanship Programs, Horse Training, as well as full care Board & Train programs. It is the mission of Dun Right to guide in education of the horse and human relationship, communication and understanding, and the lifelong lessons to be treasured with it.

Dun Right hosts camps, events, and open houses throughout the year where the Innsbrook community and guests may enjoy a "behind the scenes" in depth look into our equestrian operation. You may also stop by to see the Red Barn animals at any time from outside their fence, no appointment needed, and visit with our goats and donkey, Mighty Mouse.

This year, children can look forward to a fun-filled summer down on the farm with a variety of activities! With a Wild West Horse Camp scheduled in June, Dun Right Stables welcome children ages 8-15 to learn about different horsemanship skills involved in the sport of rodeo and how to properly groom and care for horses and farm animals.





New to the stables summer event calendar is Summer Nights at the Stables- Kids Night Out! Children ages 8-15 can enjoy making new friends around the campfire, interact with farm animals, play games and more!

The horse boarding and training facility include a competition sized indoor and outdoor arena, a recently added 60' round pen, well maintained dry lots and pastures, newly added outdoor trail course, barrels, poles and other obstacles to use, as well trail head access directly from the stables. Horse owners at Dun Right will enjoy clinics, fun shows, and arena play days, as well as many other group events held at the stables for horses and their owners to participate in.

Dun Right Stables is owned and operated by head trainer, and facility manager, Kat Metzger. The management team lives on property with over 27 active years of experience in the horse industry.

As a reminder, Dun Right Stables is a privately leased and managed facility. For the safety of all, the stables is a restricted area. Please respect the signs when visiting outside of the property fence. You must have an appointment and be with the Dun Rights management team to enter anywhere on the stables property.

Please do not feed anything, including hay or grass, to any horse, goat, donkey or other animal, including the barn cat, on the property. All the animals that live at Dun Right are loved and owned by private individuals and boarded under Dun Rights care full time. We also ask that if you encounter a horse on a trail or road, to please communicate your presence with the rider as soon as possible, and to cautiously pass or wait till the animals passes you.

RESTORING HISTORY AND CULTURE AT INNSBROOK ONE STRUCTURE AT A TIME

Innsbrook's years of growth and tradition were built on deep rooted, historical land that has now become an interest to residents and a unique part of the Innsbrook culture.

What started as a very small part of the huge land acquisition by the United States government from France in 1803, the Louisiana Purchase, has now become a historic site on the Innsbrook property. In 1997, Innsbrook Corporation purchased 400 acres, including the building known as the "Log Cabin" and surrounding land, knowing very little about the home and the historical stories hidden within its aging, wooded walls. In 2009, the Log Cabin, surrounding structures, and nearly 1.5 acres encircling them was deeded to the Innsbrook Historical Society and now make up what is called the Historic Village, located below Alpine Dam.

The Innsbrook Historical Society (IHS) was formed by a group of residents with the mission "...to restore and preserve historic structures and adjacent properties within the Village of Innsbrook in order to educate and deepen the understanding of the legacy of the land and its inhabitant." This year, the Innsbrook Historical Society is celebrating their successes dating back to 2010, with plans for new and exciting growth in the near future.

The 1840s log cabin is the staple structure of the historic village. In 2010, the dilapidated 1840s log cabin was stripped down to the bare log walls, and all old chinking was removed prior to restoration. After building a front porch, replacing wall logs, installing electric, and much more, the restoration project was completed in 2015. Today, the Log Cabin is host to community events such as live music, artist workshops, lectures, and many other activities.

Originally built near what is now the Innsbrook West gate in 1881, the Upper Charrette Schoolhouse was in use as a one-room school, providing education for area children for nearly 30 years. After being rebuilt in 1909, the schoolhouse closed in 1941, leaving it vacant with only minor maintenance completed on the structure. In 2019, IHS volunteers deconstructed the schoolhouse, moved "pieces" to the Historical Village, and reconstructed it into like-new condition. Inside, visitors will find a fully furnished schoolhouse, just as a typical one-room school of the 1900s would look like.

In 2022, IHS volunteers completed construction of a fully modernized restroom facility on site. The modern restroom facility was designed to look like a historic shed, and is now available for use for residents and guests during their visit to the historic village.

Celebrating over a decade of successes and restoring culture and history at Innsbrook, the IHS is off and running again this year, striving to make the Historical Village a destination of choice for residents and visitors. Innsbrook Historical Society members are getting closer to obtaining an old, historic barn to restore and relocate to the Historic Village. IMPORTANT REMINDERS FROM INNSBROOK SECURITY

It's always good to have a little reminder about some of the important policies that we have in place at Innsbrook for the safety of our property owners and their families and for maintaining the beauty of our community.

Please familiarize yourself with the information below:

- Remember always dial 911 first in the event of an emergency. After that, you may call Innsbrook Security at the Main Gate at ext. 9400 to make them aware of your situation. We have scanners for all emergency response communication traffic, so we will know before they arrive. Upon arrival, Innsbrook Security will lead first responders to the emergency location.
- All guests must be registered with our Security Department via the Property Owner portal before their arrival. Guests must enter Innsbrook through the Main or West Gate during staffed hours. Find a link to the portal at www.innsbrook-resort.com/propertyowners/guest-registration. If it is your first visit, you must complete a one-time registration to gain access. You can also register guests through the Innsbrook mobile app.
- Property owners can elect to receive email or text confirmation of all guest authorizations to their property. Please login to make sure we have your current email and phone number.
- Guests registered to your property (including contractors and renters) are your responsibility. For the peace of our community and your neighbors, please be sure your guests or renters (if applicable) know the rules.
- Only owners can register guests on the property. Renters and guests are not able to add additional guests to the property.
- Golf cart and recreational vehicle drivers must be at least 16 years of age and have a valid driver's license. All vehicles must be adequately insured.
- All property owner vehicles & UTV/ATVs are required to have RFID stickers. The sticker must always adhere to the windshield in the bottom left corner on the driver's side. These stickers are for owners and their immediate family members only – stickers are not to be given to friends or employees. The stickers never expire and will only be deactivated if you sell your Innsbrook property or if they are misused.

- Slow down and relax! Please obey the posted speed limits for the safety of all. 23 mph on paved roads and 17 mph on gravel. Our security team may pull speeders over to remind them of speed limits. A notification email of this will be sent out to the property associated with that individual.
- Anyone caught piggybacking guests or contractors through remote gates will have all stickers assigned to their lot deactivated. Stickers can be reactivated for a fee, which will only be allowed once.
- Trash should be placed in dumpsters and compactors, not ON dumpster lids or beside the bins (because animals will get into it and make a mess!).
- Dogs must always be on a leash and are not allowed on Innsbrook beaches.
- Personal fireworks are prohibited.
- It's essential to identify the entrance to your property for guests and emergency responders with an Innsbrook lot sign! The sign features the Innsbrook logo and matches the look of Innsbrook street signs. Call ext. 9180 or email information@innsbrook-resort.com to find out more.
- Renters and guests must be put into the portal ASAP to avoid a hold-up at the gate. Please be sure renters coming to your property know the address number for a smooth and quick security check at the gate.


