Community Compost Facility

Innsbrook is pleased to announce the opening of the Innsbrook Community Compost Facility located by the Property Management Offices. The compost facility was made possible by grant funds from the Missouri Department of Natural Resources (MDNR), the East Central Solid Waste Management District (ECSWMD), and the Innsbrook Owners Association.

The purpose for this project is to divert lawn, landscape, and kitchen waste that usually ends up in the Innsbrook dumpsters and into the landfills. Having a compost facility gives us the opportunity to reduce the amount of biodegradable substances that enter into the landfills and create an organic fertilizer that can be reused and will have a positive impact on our environment.

The size of Innsbrook's community compost facilities was designed to accommodate the estimated lawn, landscape, and kitchen waste generated by Innsbrook, and our residents. With the size of the facility we should be able to have bins to collect biodegradable materials while other bins will contain compost that is ready for the garden.

Materials Accepted

- Grass clippings
- Leaves
- Mulch
- Ornamental grass, perennial, and annual stalks
- Sod
- Shrub clippings
- Fruits, vegetables, coffee grounds, breads

Essentially any type of yard waste from typical gardening activities

Materials Not Accepted

- Plastic bags of all type
- Tree limbs
- Lumber
- Shrub clippings larger than your little finger
- Meat and cheese, or any product that is made from animals
- Cloth
- Construction waste
- Newspapers, magazines

Everybody's help will be required to make this endeavor a success.
