A tool in your property owner portal (live November 1st) will easily allow you to opt in or out for each snowstorm. Property owner's must opt in/out of the service at least 24 hours in advance of anticipated snow accumulations to ensure service.

For those whom would like to have snow plow service for the entire winter season – all you have to do is choose the seasonal opt in option once and leave it! A 24-hour advance notice is not required when this option is selected.

TRASH AND RECYCLING REMINDERS

Innsbrook offers trash/recycling depots for property owners use:

- Just south of the Main Gate on Aspen Way Dr.
- Just north of the Farmhouse off Innsbrook Dr.
- At the Konstanz Gate Entrance off South Konstanz Dr.
- At the Linden Gate Entrance off Linden Crossing

DO NOT use the trash or recycle bins at the Clubhouse Bar & Grille, Charrette Creek Commons, The Market Cafe and Creamery, or at the Aspen Center; these are for commercial use only.

*TRASH COMPACTOR

A trash compactor for household trash only is located at the trash depot just south of the Main Gate on Aspen Way Dr. TO USE THE COMPACTOR, OPEN THE SIDE DOOR, PLACE YOUR TRASH IN, CLOSE THE DOOR, AND PRESS THE GREEN BUTTON. DO NOT open the door when the green light is flashing and the siren is sounding. This indicates that the compactor is in operation. NEVER go inside the dumpster.

*RECYCLING PROGRAM

Recycling dumpsters are located at all of our trash depots. You can recycle:

- All cans (aluminum/steel/tin)
- Paper milk and juice cartons
- Green, clear and brown glass bottles
- All paper that tears (newspapers, magazines, junk mail, office paper)
- Cardboard and paper boxes such as cereal and tissue boxes
- Plastic containers, such as butter dishes, yogurt cups, etc.

Note: Items should be loose and not placed in plastic trash bags. No plastic grocery bags, window glass, dinnerware, ceramics or #6 plastics (styrofoam).

Remove paperclips/staples from paper.
All cans, bottles and cardboard (such as pizza boxes) should be free of debris.

Recyclables can be co-mingled; there's no need to separate items. There is a \$250 fine for trash/garbage thrown in the recycling bins.

NATURE NOTES

The Sounds of Fall

Fall is a sensory delight. The landscape is awash with the colors of changing leaves. Sunsets are coppery. Fall smells are evocative: cider, smoke from burning leaves, and the singed pumpkin of a jacko-lantern plug.

The sounds of fall are distinct too. Crickets call. As E.B. White wrote in "Charlotte's Web": "They sang the song of summer's ending, a sad monotonous song."

Crisp, dead leaves cover the ground and swish and crunch underfoot. Squirrels chatter and raise a leafy rattle as they scurry for acorns to bury and find again as fall fades into winter.

Deer look for mates, and they move restlessly. Bucks vying for dominance fight, and their antlers clack and scrape. A lone deer suddenly surprised is likely to snort. Wild elk chuckle, bugle and sound off in the Ozark hills.

Migrating geese cut across autumn skies in wide V's, belting out calls of reassurance to one another. The chorus of honks fills the chilly air, first softly, then stridently, and then fades away. A new fleet takes up the calm then it passes too, and the relay continues, sometimes for hours.

How can you best enjoy the sounds of fall while gazing at its changing colors? For spectacular vistas, choose routes with views of forested bluffs, and along ridges with sweeping scenes of forested landscapes. Innsbrook offers spectacular views along bluffs, creeks, and lush valleys, with abundant wildlife sightings throughout the property.

On a smaller scale, hike one of the seven walking trails at Innsbrook and experience a colorful forest canopy on a clear, bluesky day. It's like having acres of shining stained glass above
