TRASH AND RECYCLING REMINDERS

Innsbrook offers trash/recycling depots for property owners use:

- Just south of the Main Gate on Aspen Way Dr.
- Just north of the Farmhouse off Innsbrook Dr.
- At the Konstanz Gate Entrance off South Konstanz Dr.
- At the Linden Gate Entrance off Linden Crossing

DO NOT use the trash or recycle bins at the Clubhouse Bar & Grille, Charrette Creek Commons, The Market Cafe and Creamery, or at the Aspen Center; these are for commercial use only.

*TRASH COMPACTOR

A trash compactor for household trash only is located at the trash depot just south of the Main Gate on Aspen Way Dr. TO USE THE COMPACTOR, OPEN THE SIDE DOOR, PLACE YOUR TRASH IN, CLOSE THE DOOR, AND PRESS THE GREEN BUTTON. DO NOT open the door when the green light is flashing and the siren is sounding. This indicates that the compactor is in operation. NEVER go inside the dumpster.

*RECYCLING PROGRAM

Recycling dumpsters are located at all of our trash depots. You can recycle:

- All cans (aluminum/steel/tin)
- Paper milk and juice cartons
- Green, clear and brown glass bottles
- All paper that tears (newspapers, magazines, junk mail, office paper)
- Cardboard and paper boxes such as cereal and tissue boxes
- Plastic containers, such as butter dishes, yogurt cups, etc.

Note: Items should be loose and not placed in plastic trash bags. No plastic grocery bags, window glass, dinnerware, ceramics or #6 plastics (styrofoam).

Remove paperclips/staples from paper.
All cans, bottles and cardboard (such as pizza boxes) should be free of debris.

Recyclables can be co-mingled; there's no need to separate items. There is a \$250 fine for trash/garbage thrown in the recycling bins.



NATURE NOTES

Downy Gentian

Downy gentian, or prairie gentian, is a beautifully blue or violet-blue wildflower with opposite leaves that blooms September through November in native grasslands. It is a perennial wildflower with erect or ascending stems that are minutely hairy, usually in lengthwise lines up the stem. The fine, white hairs, which give this plant its name, can be hard to see.

The stem leaves are opposite, simple, lance-shaped, and stalkless. It's hard to see, but the leaves are minutely hairy along the edge of the basal part of the blade, and along the larger veins on the leaf underside. The smaller leaves at the top of the plant are whorled on the stem

Flowers arise in clusters of individual flowers at the tops of the plant stalks; petals are fused into a funnel-shaped tube, with the free portion of the outer lobes spreading at maturity, blue to bluish violet, sometimes darkening with age.

Several members of the gentian family live in Missouri, including two others in the genus Gentiana: closed gentian, or bottle gentian (G. andrewsii), and pale, white, or yellowish gentian (G. alba).

Downy gentian can interbreed and form hybrids with G. alba; these offspring are called G. x curtisii and have been documented from certain locations in Adair and Franklin counties where the two parent species grow near each other. The hybrid plants show characteristics intermediate between the parent plants.

As with other gentians, bumble bees are the principal pollinators, capable of cross-pollinating the plants; this is a reminder that a wide variety of bees and other pollinators are needed in order for our state to have a wide variety of plants.
