IBK Snow Removal

Having your driveway plowed is now easier than ever! Property Owners will have full control of when they want their driveways plowed and/or when they don't by using a tool in the Property Owner Portal that can be found at the following link: https://bit.ly/3M4vfli.

Once you have elected to receive snow removal service, you may turn it off and on as you see fit. Service must be turned on/off 24-hours in advance of an anticipated snow storm.

Plow service will only be provided for snow accumulations of three inches or more! A one-time electronic waiver is prompted when opting-in and must be accepted before your service. Land Maintenance Beginning November 1st

Southern Star Central Gas Pipeline Company, which owns and operates a 6,000 mile long natural gas pipeline system, will be doing land maintenance such as cutting trees and undergrowth beginning on November 1st. This will be mulched, and any obstructions that could interfere or endanger the safe operation of the 8" Gas-line will be removed. This work is done on a 30' wide easement 15' to each side of the Pipeline. The Pipeline enters Innsbrook properties east of Stracks Church Rd, heading east between Lake Scheffborg and Lake Lucerne.

The fees for boat moving services are \$50 for a small boat and \$150 for pontoon boats. There is a \$75 and \$150 charge for boats put in storage. At your preference, all boats can be put in our open storage facility or taken to your lot. Once they are on our lot, you only have access to it by foot and the boat cannot be moved anymore. Your boat can also be delivered to our facility and we will store it on the open lot. November 30th is the Deadline to have your boat removal scheduled for the marinas and beaches. TRASH AND RECYCLING REMINDERS

Innsbrook offers trash/recycling depots for property owners use:

- Just south of the Main Gate on Aspen Way Dr.
- Just north of the Farmhouse off Innsbrook Dr.
- At the Konstanz Gate Entrance off South Konstanz Dr.
- At the Linden Gate Entrance off Linden Crossing

DO NOT use the trash or recycle bins at the Clubhouse Bar & Grille, Charrette Creek Commons, The Market Cafe and Creamery, or at the Aspen Center; these are for commercial use only.

*TRASH COMPACTOR

A trash compactor for household trash only is located at the trash depot just south of the Main Gate on Aspen Way Dr. TO USE THE COMPACTOR, OPEN THE SIDE DOOR, PLACE YOUR TRASH IN, CLOSE THE DOOR, AND PRESS THE GREEN BUTTON. DO NOT open the door when the green light is flashing and the siren is sounding. This indicates that the compactor is in operation. NEVER go inside the dumpster.

*RECYCLING PROGRAM

Recycling dumpsters are located at all of our trash depots. You can recycle:

- All cans (aluminum/steel/tin)
- Paper milk and juice cartons
- Green, clear and brown glass bottles
- All paper that tears (newspapers, magazines, junk mail, office paper)
- Cardboard and paper boxes such as cereal and tissue boxes
- Plastic containers, such as butter dishes, yogurt cups, etc.

Note: Items should be loose and not placed in plastic trash bags. No plastic grocery bags, window glass, dinnerware, ceramics or #6 plastics (styrofoam). Remove paperclips/staples from paper. All cans, bottles and cardboard (such as pizza boxes) should be free of debris. Recyclables can be co-mingled; there's no need to separate items. There is a \$250 fine for trash/garbage thrown in the recycling bins.



NATURE NOTES

A Mushroom That's a Trick, Not a Treat

October is the essence of autumn. It also embodies the spirit of Halloween. And for many of us, there's nothing more iconic to Halloween than the Jack-o'-lantern. But did you know Missouri also has a Jack-o'-lantern mushroom? While pumpkins are edible, in the spirit of a spooky holiday, the mushroom Jack-o'-lantern is poisonous.

The Jack-o'-lantern mushroom surely look the part. It is bright orange to yellowish orange, with a convex cap that becomes flat to funnel-shaped with a center that's sunken in. The smooth skin is similar to that of a pumpkin. Its narrow gills are sharp-edged and descend from the stalk, which is curved . . . not unlike the stalk of a pumpkin.

In addition to trying to trick us into thinking they're pumpkins, it's said that these mushrooms can pull off another Halloween trick; they can glow in the dark, just like a Jack-o'-lantern! The bioluminescent gills of fresh specimens sometimes give off an eerie, faint greenish glow at night.

You can find Jack-o'-lantern mushrooms growing in large clusters at the base of trees, on stumps, or on buried wood from July and throughout October all over Missouri. Eating a Jack-o'-lantern mushroom would most definitely not be a treat, however. Though they are not typically deadly to healthy adults, a mild to severe upset stomach lasting for several days would result from making these mushrooms a Halloween snack

Like trick-or-treaters, Jack-o'-lanterns can masquerade as something else they aren't either. People often confuse them with the edible and delicious chanterelle mushroom because Jack-o'-lanterns have very similar colors and shapes. Always positively identify any mushroom you intend to eat before doing so!

For a Halloween trick this month, why not hike through the woods and try to spot the Jack-o'-lantern mushroom lurking on a forest floor? You'll know it's doing the vital job of recycling while masquerading as a pumpkin. Just don't try to make a "treat" out of it. Save that for your Halloween candy.
