#### Innsbrook Spring Fishing Tournament

## Sat., Apr. 6 | 6:30 a.m.-12 p.m. | FH

Tournament is open to any property owners and their families, guests, and vacationers staying at IBK. There are two divisions to compete in:

- Kids division can be a single or twoperson team with participants being 15 years of age or younger. These teams can catch any species of fish. Anglers can use natural or artificial lures and baits. Each team's total weight of fish will be used to determine the heaviest stringer winner.
- Adult division (16+ years of age) is a single or two-person format. A team can only check in largemouth bass over 12 inches in length. Anglers may only use artificial lures and baits. Each team can weigh-in up to 10 bass.

It is suggested that largemouth bass smaller than 12 inches be kept during the tournament to help improve our lakes. The Fishing Club will collect these small bass to be recycled as a food source for the Wildbird Sanctuary Rehabilitation Center. Please collect as many small bass as possible while fishing the tournament.

Weigh-in will occur at the Oh'Fishal Scale, located at the Farmhouse at Noon. All teams must arrive before Noon to be checked in. The Fishing Club will have an attendance prize drawing for all children.




## Weekly Senior Golf Scramble

## Don't Be "Trashy"

Innsbrook offers trash/recycling depots for property owners use:

- Just south of the Main Gate on Aspen Way Dr.
- Just north of the Farmhouse off Innsbrook Dr.
- At the Konstanz Gate Entrance off South Konstanz Dr.
- At the Linden Gate Entrance off Linden Crossing

DO NOT use the trash or recycle bins at the Clubhouse Bar & Grille, Charrette Creek Commons, or at the Aspen Center; these are for commercial use only.

#### Trash Compactor

A trash compactor for household trash only is located at the trash depot just south of the Main Gate on Aspen Way Dr. To use the compactor, open the side door, place your trash in, and close the door. The compactor turns on automatically when trash reaches a certain point. DO NOT open the door when the green light is flashing and the siren is sounding. This indicates that the compactor is in operation. NEVER go inside the dumpster.

#### Prohibited Items

The following items are PROHIBITED in all Innsbrook dumpsters:

- Iron or steel
- Car parts or tires
- Construction debris, such as lumber, drywall, fixtures, etc.
- Appliances or bulky trash items such as furniture, mattresses, etc.
- Oil, paint or chemicals requiring special disposal
- Car batteries, ammo, and chemicals

#### Spring Big Trash Weekend!

For two days only, April 6-April 7 from 9 a.m. to 4 p.m., dumpsters will be available for disposal of your bulky, unwanted items and trash -- including furniture at the Property Management Building. No construction or auto waste will be accepted, so no toilets, bathtubs, broken tiles, and no auto parts or tires! Only bring items from your Innsbrook property, absolutely no outside waste, please.

#### Security at Trash Sites

To maintain cleanliness and efficiency, we'll be imposing a \$250 fee for improper use of our dumpsters or compactors. Our enhanced surveillance allows us to monitor activities closely, ensuring that only appropriate items are disposed of.
