Bluebird Trail Report:

There are three different species of bluebirds in the United States. Our Eastern Bluebird, the Mountain Bluebird and the Western Bluebird. The Eastern Bluebird male has a red-brown throat and upper chest with a blue back. The female is more two-toned with a dull reddish brown front and a blue-gray head and back. The Eastern Bluebird breeds throughout the eastern half of the U.S. and southern Canada. Some bluebirds in the north migrate south in the winter while others remain in their home territory. Many of our birds remain in our area for the winter unless we get extremely cold and icy weather conditions. Then, they may move a few hundred miles south. Typical bluebird habitat is open land with scattering of trees and low or sparse vegetation.

Our bluebirds presently have made 93 nests containing 283 eggs and 66 chcicks. Please send your reports and/or questions to Shirley at saritsema@gmail.com.

NATURE NOTES

Understanding Copperheads

If copperheads are a fear factor for you, there is hope and help. Since they don't look like other Missouri snakes, they are easy to identify and avoid.

Missouri's copperheads are pinkish tan with dark-brown markings along their backs that are shaped like an hourglass or bow tie. This camouflage look helps them hide from prey in leaves along rocky hillsides and forest edges. They make excellent exterminators as their diet is mostly mice and voles.

Copperheads are active from April through November, and have young from August through early October. They are not aggressive and seldom strike unless provoked.

Discourage copperheads from around your home by getting rid of wood or rock piles and tall grass. Wear boots when in woods or brushy fields, and leather gloves when moving rocks, old lumber and firewood.

With the upcoming serge of cicadas, be careful when around trees and shrubs, as copperheads enjoy these noisy insects as a late night snack.

Cicadas that shed their skins are a food source for copperheads. These snakes are more active at night during the summertime. They prey on the insects when they emerge from their holes, which can be found around trees.

But, more cicadas does not mean necessarily mean more snakes in your yard. Some people are concerned about seeing more copperhead snakes, which feed on cicadas and other small animals. While they do appear around the same time, there is not significant data proving this correlation.
