Things to Know Before You Begin Your Spring Upgrades

It is a popular time of year for household upgrades and we want to make the process as seamless and stress free as possible. Here are a few Innsbrook guidelines to remember before beginning your projects!

Outbuildings:

- Outbuildings are prohibited on lots other than a-frame lots
- All outbuildings must receive ARB or Building Commissioner approval before installation
- Outbuildings shall not be located between chalet and lake and must have placement approved
- One outbuilding is allowed per lot
- The maximum size is 168 sq ft

Docks:

- One dock is allowed per lot
- Maximum surface of 160 square feet, not including steps, is allowed
- Floating docks are not permitted
- The ARB must approve all docks

Permits:

It is highly recommended to apply for permits two weeks before starting any projects or ordering any materials. When applying for your permit, make sure to include the following:

- Placement proposal
- Plan or sketch
- All materials/colors to be used

Bluebird Trail Report:

Our bluebirds are really working hard. They now have 104 nests containing 208 eggs and 231 hungry chicks. This is their best start ever!

Unfortunately their cousins, the mountain bluebird, is not doing as well and their numbers are declining. They are slightly larger than the eastern bluebirds with longer and thinner bills and longer wings. The male is almost all blue with no red on their breasts. Just a little bit of white under their tails. The female is all grayish brown with just a bit of blue on her wing feathers. They are usually found in the higher elevations- about 5,000 feet and in meadows and open rangeland. It breeds in all the western states and the western Canadian provinces. It is the most migratory of all the bluebirds. Their range overlaps that of the western bluebird and there are reports of the two species pairing together and producing hybrid young.
