Innsbrook Spring Fishing Tournament

Sat., Apr. 6 | 6:30 a.m.-12 p.m. | FH

Tournament is open to any property owners and their families, guests, and vacationers staying at IBK. There are two divisions to compete in:

- Kids division can be a single or two-person team with participants being 15 years of age or younger. These teams can catch any species of fish. Anglers can use natural or artificial lures and baits. Each team's total weight of fish will be used to determine the heaviest stringer winner.
- Adult division (16+ years of age) is a single or two-person format. A team can only check in largemouth bass over 12 inches in length. Anglers may only use artificial lures and baits. Each team can weigh-in up to 10 bass.

It is suggested that largemouth bass smaller than 12 inches be kept during the tournament to help improve our lakes. The Fishing Club will collect these small bass to be recycled as a food source for the Wildbird Sanctuary Rehabilitation Center. Please collect as many small bass as possible while fishing the tournament.

Weigh-in will occur at the Oh'Fisnal Scale, located at the Farmhouse at Noon. All teams must arrive before Noon to be checked in. The Fishing Club will have an attendance prize drawing for all children.

Trash and Recycling Reminders

We have conveniently located trash and recycling depots throughout the community:

- Just south of the Main Gate on Aspen Way Dr.
- Just north of the Farmhouse off Innsbrook Dr.
- At the Konstanz Gate Entrance off South Konstanz Dr.
- At the Linden Gate Entrance off Linden Crossing

Please refrain from using the bins at the Clubhouse Bar & Grille, Charrette Creek Commons, The Market Café and Creamery, or Aspen Center, as they are designated for commercial use only.

Please refrain from disposing of the following items in our dumpsters:

- Iron or steel
- Car parts or tires
- Construction debris (e.g., lumber, drywall, fixtures)
- Appliances or bulky items such as furniture and mattresses
- Oil, paint, or chemicals requiring special disposal
- Car batteries

We also offer recycling dumpsters at all of our trash depots. Accepted recyclables include:

- All cans (aluminum/steel/tin)
- Paper milk and juice cartons
- Green, clear, and brown glass bottles
- All paper tears (newspapers, magazines, junk mail, office paper)
- Cardboard and paper boxes
- Plastic containers

Recyclable items should be loose and not placed in plastic trash bags. No plastic grocery bags, window glass, dinnerware, ceramics or #6 plastics (styrofoam). Remove paperclips/staples from paper. All cans, bottles and cardboard (such as pizza boxes) should be free of debris. Recyclables can be co-mingled; there's no need to separate items.

Dumpsters will be available at the Property Management Building from 9 a.m. to 4 p.m. for disposal of bulky, unwanted items and trash, including furniture. IBK Fishing Club Tips

A jerk bait is an effective lure in the early spring. The bait is generally shaped by a long, thin minnow. When not in motion, the lure suspends within the water column. Its capacity to linger makes the bait tempting to slow-moving spring game fish. Activating a jerk bait requires some technique. The angler has to balance movement with times of suspension. The childhood A-B-C song provides the proper cadence. Jerk the bait from its suspension by pulling hard on the line at the end of every phrase. A-B-C-jerk, E-F-G-jerk.

PLEIN AIR ART CLASSES

What is Plein Air Art?

Innsbrook offers a variety of classes and workshops for owners and guests to experience different outlets of art and creativity, one of which is plein air art. This particular art form is focused on an artist leaving the four walls of their studio behind and experiencing painting and drawing in the landscape. The practice denotes a nineteenth-century style of painting outdoors, or with a strong sense of the open air, that became a central feature of French impressionism. Their desire to paint light and its changing, ephemeral qualities, coupled with the creation of transportable paint tubes and the box easel, allowed artists the freedom to paint "en plein air," which is the French expression for painting in open air.

Capture the beauty of Innsbrook with our plein air art classes using watercolors. Mary Dee Schmidt, a watercolor instructor at Missouri Botanical Gardens for over thirty years, will lead each class and teach new techniques and composition skills with professional demonstrations and group critiques. NATURE NOTES

Tornado Season: Are You Ready?

In the Midwest states, peak tornado occurrence is in mid-March through late June. Missouri is considered at high risk from tornadoes and is in "tornado alley," which place the state in the top five for tornado activity. Check out the below information on how to stay safe during major storms in your area.

Know what to listen for:

- A "Tornado Watch" is issued when tornadoes are possible in your area. Remain alert for approaching storms.
- A "Tornado Warning" is issued when a tornado has been sighted or indicated by weather radar. Move to your pre-designated place of safety.

Stay informed of weather conditions by tuning into local radio and television stations, and take all watches and warnings seriously. Remember, tornadoes develop in areas where a severe thunderstorm watch or warning is in effect, so listen for that information as well. Remain alert!

Know what you can do - tornado safety: Before the storm

- Develop a plan for you and your family for home, work, school, and when outdoors.
- Hold frequent drills.
- Purchase an NOAA weather radio for your home.
- Know the county in which you live, and keep a highway map nearby to follow storm movement from weather bulletins.
- Listen to radio and television for information.

During the storm

- In a home or building, move to a pre-designated shelter, such as a basement.
- If an underground shelter is not available, move to an interior room or hallway on the lowest floor, and get under a sturdy piece of furniture.
- Stay away from windows.
- Get out of automobiles.
- Do not try to outrun a tornado in your car; instead, leave it immediately. If caught outside or in a vehicle, lie flat in a nearby ditch or depression.
