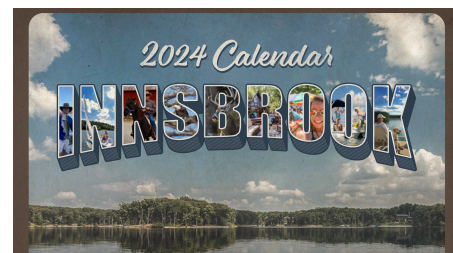

IBK Snow Removal

Having your driveway plowed is now easier than ever! Property Owners will have full control of when they want their driveways plowed and/or when they don't by using a **tool in the Property Owner Portal that can be found at the following link:** <https://bit.ly/3M4vfii>.

Once you have elected to receive snow removal service, you may turn it off and on as you see fit. *Service must be turned on/off 24-hours in advance of an anticipated snow storm.*

Plow service will only be provided for snow accumulations of three inches or more! A one-time electronic waiver is prompted when opting-in and must be accepted before your service.
