NATURE NOTES

Winter Wildlife Watching

The reviews call it, "Magnificent; a feast for the eyes and ears."

One of the greatest migration spectacles in the Midwest happens in Missouri. This is one crowd you can safely stand in the midst and watch teems of waterfowl block out the sky at peak times. Stand out visitors include massive quantities of snow geese, a diversity of ducks and birds, trumpeter swans, pelicans, bald eagles, herons and more. You can also view resident wildlife including deer, beavers, muskrats, and turtles.

The best time to see the show is between Thanksgiving and Christmas before the waters freeze and our wild visitors move south.

Snow geese by the thousands are visiting western Missouri this month. The Arctic-nesting geese have made their annual migration from the north. They rest in huge flocks on open water, sometimes rising in loud honking swirls of white and gray. The geese fly back and forth from feeding areas when not resting.

A winter bonus is that large, and quite white, trumpeter swans also can be spotted at various lakes and wetlands in Missouri. For all waterfowl watching, cameras and binoculars are useful accessories.
