Welcome to Innsbrook, kick your shoes off and stay a while.



Always improving, the course has undergone some updates and upgrades in the last year, including the installation of a drainage system on the driving range, soon-to-be delivered GPS-enabled golf carts, upgraded restrooms on the course, and at the end of your game, you'll find the perfect place to rest and dine at the Par Bar's new patio just outside the Pro Shop.


### Par Bar and Patio

In 2021, the Par Bar rolled its way into its VIP parking space at the turn and end of the 18th hole, providing a literal meal on wheels for property owners, players, and guests alike. The Par Bar's attractive new form and convenient location offers an additional eatery in the Innsbrook community for those to swing by for a quick bite on the way to the next tee box, or a place to dine alfresco with family on the new pro shop patio. This year, the Par Bar is back and better than ever with delicious new menu items, a line-up of summer events, and an eager staff of Innsbrook all-stars ready to please palates with their easy-to-eat and on-the-go favorites.



The unique "19th hole" food truck features delicious golf-themed items and ice-cold beverages. Patrons can experience a "Caddy Shack" meal with "The Bill Murray" bratwurst, or get a little taste of Augusta with the "Master" turkey and provolone sandwich. Par Bar originals including the Par Bar premium burger, Par Bar Chicken Club, and Innsbrook's popular funnel fries are just a few of the other menu options bursting with flavor.

Along with the new additions to the menu, patrons can now enjoy lunch and cocktails on the expanded patio right outside of the pro shop doors. Recently outfitted with a custom pergola, cozy course-side seating and outdoor games, the patio serves as the perfect place to relax on a sunny Saturday afternoon surrounded by the scenic views of the championship golf course. With a focus on providing the Innsbrook community and guests a unique outdoor dining experience and an additional space to gather with family friends, patrons can expect a summer calendar sprinkled with golf specials, live music, events and parties at the Par Bar.



## Upgrades Along the Course

New technology is hitting the course this year in the form of four-wheels. Players will soon ride through their nine or 18-holes of play in a new fleet of Club Car golf carts. The new carts feature a GPS system on each cart that will provide players a picture of the hole they are playing on a digital screen, as well as yardage to the pin. The new carts will also allow golf course management to track all golf carts, monitor pace of play, restrict parts of the course where carts are prohibited, and send messages to specific golf carts from inside the pro shop. This high-level of technology will deliver helpful and real-time location information for players to manage their pace of play and plan their next shot, as well as a cost-effective and efficient communication system for golf course management to instantly communicate with players.

Along with the new carts, players will notice the recently remodeled course restrooms between the 13th and 16th holes, as well as the upgrades in the Pro Shop. The upgraded pro shop welcomes players, property owners, and guests to the hub of the golf course with new flooring, paint, and a coffee station installed earlier this year.

These improvements and additions offer benefits far beyond a round of golf. Property owners and guests can look forward to an ever-improving and beautiful environment on and around the course, as well as new amenities to enhance the Innsbrook golf experience.

## No More Lost Range Balls

Players who wish to take a few practice swings at the driving range before they hit the links will now experience a drier, more functional range environment. During the off-season, the course installed multiple drains throughout the range that connect to a 12" drain pipe that spans the entire length of the driving range. Prior to the installation, the driving range was not equipped with a drainage system, causing the range to hold excess amounts of precipitation, as well as lose range balls in the quagmire. The new system will prevent the range from holding excessive amounts of water and in turn, allow the course to keep the driving range open more often than in previous seasons.

## SADDLE UP FOR EQUINE FUN DUN RIGHT AT INNSBROOK'S STABLES

*There's a relaxing sensation when a horse lover steps onto the field, tacks up and mounts their horse, especially on a beautiful, sunny day at Innsbrook. When the clippity-clop of the horse's shoes begin drumming the ground, riders are at ease taking in the sights of the stables updates, clean trails and amazing views.*

The equestrian experience is blossoming at Innsbrook Stables this spring and continues to grow under its new management by Dun Right Stables, with more exciting changes on the horizon.

In 2020, Kat Metzger and Aaron Bahr of Dun Right Stables assumed management of the facility. Kat is a graduate from Michigan State University, where she learned in-depth approaches to equine business management, breeding, training, feeding, and exercise plans. With more than 25 years of involvement in the horse community as a ranch worker and horse trainer in Colorado, a caregiver for the world-renowned touring Clydesdale team of St. Louis and, most recently, as a coach, instructor, and equine professional in Missouri, Kat has brought her passion for horses to Innsbrook.



Along with Kat comes her business partner and spouse, Aaron Bahr. Aaron is an avid animal lover, and has a passion for the quality and care of the horses. Aaron

brings a substantial management and maintenance background to the team and has been instrumental in the daily operations at the stables.

Over the last couple of years, Innsbrook has completely renovated the pastures. Due to a major change in operational management of the pastures and advisement from the Natural Resource Conservation Service, the stables began implementing best practices to maintain healthy, green, sustainable pastures throughout the year. To aid this goal, dry lot areas for horse turn out were also developed. Because of the significant updates and efficient management of the grassland pastures, the stables now have lush, green fields for the horses to enjoy.

Guests and frequent visitors to the stables will also notice additional improvements including a fresh coat of paint on the buildings, and the completion of a hitching post area under the trees.

Bringing something new and unique to the stables, Kat and her team added a petting zoo area to the Red Barn. Now home to several goats and a donkey, Mighty Mouse, the first step towards future plans of opening the Red Barn as a tour barn is complete. Adults and children alike can enjoy visiting Innsbrook's newest, and cutest, residents.

Property owners may also look forward to stable tours, hay rides, holiday horse parades, and additional riding opportunities throughout the summer.

This year, children can look forward to a fun-filled summer down on the farm with a variety of activities! With two dates in June divided by age groups, Dun Right Stables will host a Beginner Weeklong Summer Break Horse Camp for children ages 7-10, and an Intermediate-Advanced Weeklong Summer Break Horse Camp for children ages 10-14. Campers will enjoy arts and crafts, farm activities, and of course, horseback riding! New to the stables summer event calendar is Summer Nights at the Stables-Kids Night Out! With three dates scheduled in June and July, children ages 7-12 can enjoy a night of arts and crafts, games, a campfire, and more!

Due to popular demand, Dun Right Stables is offering Summer Horse Day Camps for all ages, even adults (18 years and over), beginning in June! Summer Day Camps will run from 10 a.m.-1 p.m. and will include games, mini riding lessons in the arena, crafts, and more!

For a more private, one-on-one experience, Dun Right Stables offers riding lessons for those interested in weekly year-round lessons, as well as private tractor drawn rides and stable tours. Private tours include a 30 minute behind the scenes look of the stables and must be reserved in advance.

As a reminder to all, please do not feed the horses or any animals at the stables. Many of our equine boarders are on special diets or have allergies. Innsbrook's barns are private facilities that are home to our privately owned horses and animals. For the safety of all (including horses) only boarders and guests with pre-booked appointments may enter inside the stables' gates. We also ask cars, ATVs, cyclers, and walkers to be aware when encountering mounted horse riders, as horses can get startled easily.


concert (7:30 p.m.) to follow. The Friday evening Concert will encompass many of your favorite movie music tunes including Titanic, Aladdin, and more!

# IMPORTANT REMINDERS FROM INNSBROOK SECURITY

*It's always good to have a little reminder about some of the important policies that we have in place at Innsbrook for the safety of our property owners and their families and for maintaining the beauty of our community.*

Please familiarize yourself with the information below:

- Remember – always dial 911 first in the event of an emergency. After that, if you have the chance, you may wish to call Innsbrook Security at the Main Gate at ext. 9400 to make them aware of your situation. Upon arrival, Innsbrook Security will lead first responders to the location of the emergency.
- All guests must be registered with our Security Department via the Property Owner Portal prior to their arrival. All guests must enter Innsbrook through the Main Gate or the West Gate during staffed hours. Find a link to the portal at [www.innsbrook-resort.com/property-owners/guest-registration](http://www.innsbrook-resort.com/property-owners/guest-registration). If it is your first visit, you will need to complete a one-time registration to gain access. You can also register guests through the Innsbrook mobile app.
- Property owners now receive email confirmation of all guest authorizations to their property. You may also log in to the portal and elect to receive email or text alerts when your guests arrive. Please log in to make sure we have your current email and phone number.
- Guests registered to your property (this includes renters as well) are your responsibility. For the peace of our community and your neighbors, please be sure your guests or renters (if applicable) are aware of the rules.
- Only owners are able to register guests to the property. Renters and guests are not able to add additional guests to the property.
- Golf cart and recreational vehicle drivers must be at least 16 years of age and have a valid driver's license. All vehicles must be properly insured.
- All property owner vehicles are required to have car stickers. These stickers are for owners and their immediate family members only – stickers are not to be given to friends or employees. The stickers never expire and will only be deactivated if you sell your Innsbrook property or if they are misused.
- Car stickers must be affixed to your vehicle's windshield and should be placed in the lower-left corner of the driver's side.
- Slow down and relax! Please obey the posted speed limits for the safety of all.
- Anyone caught sneaking guests or contractors in through remote gates will have all of the stickers assigned to their lot deactivated. Stickers can be re-activated for a fee, which you will only be allowed to do one time.
- Trash should be kept IN dumpsters and compactors, not ON dumpster lids or beside the bins (because animals will get into it and make a mess!).
- Is your property's security alarm functioning properly? Call Innsbrook Security at ext. 9400 next time you're here and we can tell you! Innsbrook Services can repair your existing alarm system or install a new one for you.
- Dogs must be on a leash at all times and are not allowed on Innsbrook beaches.
- Personal fireworks are prohibited.
- Clearly identify the entrance to your property for guests and emergency responders with an Innsbrook lot sign! The sign features the Innsbrook logo and matches the look of Innsbrook street signs. Call ext. 9180 or email [information@innsbrook-resort.com](mailto:information@innsbrook-resort.com) to find out more.
- Renters and guests need to be put into the portal ASAP to avoid hold up at the gate. Please be sure renters coming to your property are aware of the address number for a smooth and quick transition at the gate.
- Please call ext. 9150 for services issues after hours or on weekends.
- For weather related power outages, please call Cuivre River Electric (800)-392-3709 for an ETA on when power will be restored.




