Recyclables should be placed in bins loose or in paper bags. No plastic bags of any kind or styrofoam should be placed in recycle bins. Here's what you can recycle:

## APPROVED RESIDENTIAL CONTAINERS



Soda, water, mouthwash, ketchup & salad dressing bottles



Milk & juice jugs



Detergent, fabric softener, shampoo & cosmetic containers



Narrow neck containers, health & beauty aid products, household cleaners



Squeezable packaging & grocery containers



Containers for margarine, yogurt, cottage cheese, etc.



Narrow neck containers



Steel & tin cans



Plastic buckets (5-gallon size max)



Clean aluminum cans, foil, pie pans & food trays



Glass bottles & jars of any color. No window glass, ceramics, mirrors or dinnerware

## APPROVED RESIDENTIAL PAPER PRODUCTS



Newspaper, including inserts (remove plastic sleeve)



Cardboard (please break down boxes)



Kraft bags (brown paper bags)



Office, computer, notebook & gift wrap paper



Carrier stock (soda & beer can carrying cases)



Junk mail and envelopes (even with plastic windows)



Chipboard (cereal, cake & food mix boxes, gift boxes, etc.)



Paperback books (no hardcover books)



Magazines, catalogs & telephone books

## **IMPORTANT NOTES:**

- 1. Please rinse containters.
- 2. Caps, lids and labels are okay.
- 3. No containers for motor oil, insecticide, herbicide or hazardous chemicals.
- 4. No plastic bags of any kind (return shopping bags to the store).
- 5. No Styrofoam or polystyrene.
- 6. No paper towels, tissues or wipes.
- 7. No large trash save it for big trash weekends
